## April Report of the Month: PRO Report

**Learn how to use the PRO report to easily review your performance on the Person-Centered Primary Care PRO Measure and the Physician Trust PRO Measure.**

Dr. Kahn's top priorities as a solo practitioner are her patient's health, and her relationship with them. For these reasons, she chose to adopt the Person Centered Primary Care Measure (PCPCM), an 11 question patient survey designed to measure high value aspects of primary care based on the patient's relationship with their clinician or practice. Adopting this measure was an easy choice given the low burden adoption, and management within her PRIME Registry dashboard.

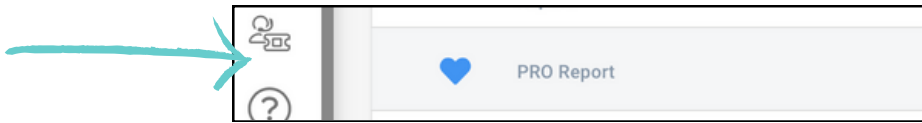
Dr. Kahn uses the PRO Report in the PRIME Registry's reports module to review and report her data on the PCPCM. Your practice can do the same:

From the main Quality Dashboard page, navigate to the **report module** by selecting the **Report icon** on the left hand navigation pane.

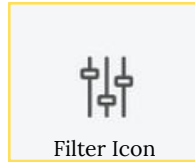

Then select the **PRO Report**



Next, select the **filter icon**, in the bar to the right of the report title.



A window will pop up, where it's easy to customize the report to your unique specifications:

Type in 'requester name', and select the report output format (csv, xls).

Select the PRO instrument from the drop down menu.

Choose the reporting time period, the clinicians and patient groups you would like to see.

Dr. Kahn wants to see which of her patients have completed the PCPCM survey, and the last date reminders to complete the survey were sent in the last quarter.

Because the PCPCM and Physician Trust surveys are confidential, the reports for those PRO measures will return patient details, including their email addresses and the completion status of the survey, but will NOT show individual patients' responses to the questions.

Set the requested delivery date. This date can be set in the future! This feature allows Dr. Kahn to create quarterly reports that will generate automatically on the date she needs them, saving time and effort on a quarterly basis.

**Did you know?** PCPCM is reportable for MIPS, is included in MIPS Value Pathways, Making Care Primary and many other newly introduced payment models.
